Presidents Report - Rachel Zimmerman

- **Wall Update** Rachel provided an update on the timeline, anticipated profit, installation, lighting, and wall painting. The cost of the wall is \$17,700, with engraving at 85 cents/letter. Samples of the tiles were shown. The wall comes preassembled with a 12-week production time. FBPA is working with the school administration to paint the walls and improve the lighting. The original 10 bricks have special placement. All original bricks will be replaced. There are 125 tiles in the first order (\$1800). A minimum of 30 tiles are required for engraving. The board anticipates a \$6000 profit on the new wall when all tiles are sold. A suggestion was made to place a page in the musical program with a picture of the wall and a QR code to purchase tiles.
- **Logo/ website** the new logo has been designed and approved by the district. The website is built with the content being uploaded. www.berlinperformingarts.org
- Pride Day Pride Day will be put on hold until fall of 2025. In place of Pride Day, we are asking all performing arts students and families to volunteer for two shifts in spring concessions. Financially we can wait until next fall for this fundraiser. District guidelines will be followed. Thai S. is asking the FBPA board to establish a committee to help design neighborhood mapping routes.
- Senior keychain update- 53 senior keychains will be distributed this year.

 - We are still looking for a volunteer from the orchestra to help on this committee.
 - Leads Eight leads are needed to open/close each event and ensure the smooth function of the concession stand. Each lead will work approximately 5-6 games each. Currently, there is only 1 returning lead. We are looking for 2 from each grade level
- **Spring concessions:** We are looking for help with spring concessions. We will need leads for nightly events. This is a great opportunity for volunteers to learn the ropes at events that are not as busy as fall sports. We will reach out to Berlin Middle School parents to seek new volunteers. Ideas on how to recruit volunteers for spring concessions were discussed including theme nights, program shifts (band/orchestra/choir), seniors, etc. Enticements were also discussed: free tickets for shows, and priority seating.

- **Choir** Choir ensembles had 8 performances in 10 days including multi-cultural festival, Sarah Moore assisted living, and Delaware tree lighting. Donated \$2400 to Delaware

- **Band** (provided by Thai) Band concert is 3/9 followed by competition on March 14 & 15. Twin babies are here! Mr. Reeves appreciates all the support the family has been provided.
