Concessions- Shelly

- Power needs - We are struggling with power problems throughout the concession stand with power not being in the correct places. We are talking about electric needs with facilities and Dewey to see if we can get them addressed this winter.
- Storage - we need additional storage to keep stock on site vs at a home. In addition, we could use another freezer, 1-2 Pepsi coolers, a lockable freezer, and an additional pretzel machine.

President Report- Rachel

- Mr. Jagger and Thai spoke about district requirements for adults. Every adult will need to be background checked prior to the event. Students will be dropped off in neighborhoods with an adult supervising, but not driving. We will need to consider advertising for events; possibly giving away raffle tickets, and other inticements for participation. We have raised approximately \$14000 in previous years that we are taking as a loss for this year. Additionally, the absence of 5th Quarter this year resulted in approximately \$20000 loss (\$10k concessions, \$8500 tix, \$1600 shirts). Thanks to good accounting practices, we should be fine for this year.
- Flowers - The swim team will be selling flowers before and during intermission of our fall performance. We will post on social media and email theater parents to let them know.
- Bricks - We have had many problems with the bricks for the wall, including cuts, thickness, engraving and storage. Can the woodshop class do the engraving if we switch to wood? Rachel will ask. Voted to replace bricks with wood planks.
- Senior Gifts - FBPA provides gifts for all seniors who have come through the program. The key chains are in and we are adding note to them that they are from FBPA.
- We should consider how to add concessions for theater performances. Approximately 800 people to be served in about 15 minutes.
